### Neighborhood Volunteer Day September 14, 2024

The major focus of the 2024 Woodlands Volunteer day was to improve several common areas by adding flowering plants, ferns, and small shrubs to beds along the drive as you enter the Woodlands (behind garages 1, 2 and 3). It was a relief when rain expected after tropical storm Francine largely missed us.





The down side: the ground was really hard, making the cobra tool necessary to dig holes for planting. The other goal for the day was neighborhood cleanup, focused on sweeping and spraying out the trash corrals.

The event concluded with a delicious potluck lunch of salads, fruit, desserts and – a highlight – Korean barbecue by Jeff Cupp, henceforth Chef Jeff!





2024 Community Volunteer Day

Lunch was served on the "pond deck," i.e., the deck overlooking the drainage basin that is currently being repaired.

In all, 19 volunteers contributed to Volunteer Day in some way, whether by planning and organizing in advance, planting and watering on the day itself, or post-event cleanup and record-keeping. These volunteer hours count toward



the match our community must provide to the Neighborhood Improvement Grant (NIG) received from the City. A half-dozen volunteers worked over the summer weeding the common areas, foremost among them Keith Mize, who put in 30-plus hours most weeks. Thanks, Keith! A team of volunteers is in place to water the new plants going forward.

#### 2024 Regular Fall Maintenance Work:

- 1. March-December Landscaping completes many tasks to maintain the grounds & safety of the buildings.
- 2. Regular mowing of the grass spring through fall
- 3. Bush trimming in the spring and fall
- 4. Leaf blowing in the fall (fronts/sides of units, common areas and streets/sidewalks, leaves mulched in the rear)
- 5. Branch removal once per month, tree trimming in the fall.
- 6. Bluestone tree conducts woody invasive management four times per year, to remove vines/bushes/trees and stray trees that start to grow too close to buildings
- 7. Chimney inspections occur in the fall.
- 8. Snow/Ice removal services as needed (2+ inches for snow)
